

She completed her Post Graduate Diploma in Personnel Management and Industrial Relations from XLRI, Jamshedpur and her Fellow Program in Management (Doctoral Degree) from IIM Bangalore. She has worked for Wipro Ltd, P&P Group, a Bangalore based boutique consulting firm and Bangalore Medical Services Trust, a not for profit organization.

During her academic career of 16 years, she has taught courses in the area of HRM across different programs in India and abroad. She was also the ICCR Chair Professor of Corporate Responsibility and Governance at the HHL School of Management, Leipzig, Germany in 2012-13. She was a British Council Visiting Scholar at the International Centre for Corporate Social Responsibility at the Nottingham University Business School.

Her areas of interest are women in management and boards, generational diversity, ethics as an elective in business schools and ethics and CSR in healthcare.

She has published extensively in peer reviewed journals. She has done research projects for Society for Human Resource Management, Anita Borg Institute and National Stock Exchange. She runs a website www.teachcsr.com — with a current user base of over 900 teachers — which is intended to enable faculty in business schools to enhance their knowledge and understanding of ethics and CSR.

Vice-Chancellor, Xavier University Bhubaneswar Director, XIM, Bhubaneswar




CEO and Co-Founder, Stories in Motion

Mr. Pandiarajan is currently the Minister for School Education and Sports and Youth Welfare of Tamil Nadu. He is also in-charge of Archaeology, Museums and Library.

He completed his engineering from PSG College of Technology, Coimbatore and pursued his MBA programme in Industrial Relations at XLRI. After graduating from XLRI in 1984, he joined the Indian operations of the multinational company BOC at Kolkata and later moved to Chennai to join Deutsche Babcock.

In 1992, he co-founded Ma Foi Management Consultants along with his wife Latha, to tap into opportunities arising out of the economic liberalisation policy in India. The initial focus of the consultancy was to place middle-level and managerial people overseas, especially in West and South East Asia and later MaFoi grew to be one of the largest temporary staffing companies in India having more than 75,000 deputes.

He is the recipient of the Eisenhowar fellowship awarded by the United States of America for his contribution to Human Resources and Consulting. He is actively involved in CII, FICCI and many other associations like Chennai Angels, Native Lead.

**Current Position:** 


Advisor to senior business leaders














