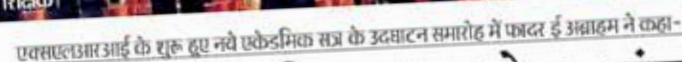

XLRI welcomes new batch

A bunch of 537 aspiring managers took a big step towards realising their career goals on their first day at XLRI, Jamshedpur, which kicked off its 2017-19 academic session on Monday.

The B-school welcomed the freshers with an introductory programme at Tata auditorium that began with an inaugural prayer followed by a short speech on the values of the institute and the importance of keeping one's integrity intact on the path to excellence.

A total of 537 students have enrolled for the three flagship programmes — business management, human resource management and general management — this year. While the business and human resource management courses have 181 students each, the general management programme will accommodate 109. Apart from this, 51 students have enrolled in the three-year PG diploma in management (part time), nine

Some of the brightest minds in the corporate sector hail from this B-school and like all, I am here to gain a varied perspective from my interactions with students and learned faculty members."

Big dreams for farmers' daughters

Babita Rani Das, daughter of farmers from Chakulia, learnt on Friday that with the right attitude and a thirst to learn, she could become anything, from a journalist to a TV anchor.

This Plus Two arts pass-out was among 500 alumni of nine state-run Kasturba Gandhi Balika Vidyalyayas (KGBVs) in East Singhbhum who came for a first-of-its-kind career counselling session in Jamshedpur.

Meant for KGBV alumni who got Plus Two results this year, the workshop organised by East Singhbhum district administration at Michael John Auditorium in Bistupur equipped them with basic know-how on career choices before college.

East Singhbhum DC Amit Kumar, district education officer (DEO) R.K.P. Singh, XLRI dean (academics) Ashis K. Pani, educationist Lalita Saareen, deputy director (employment) S.B. Jha, trainers and officials from education department and Kolhan University spoke to the girls on careers.

For KGBV alumni — many of them first-generation learners and mostly daughters of farmers, daily wagers and homemakers — it was a huge deal to be able to dream of careers, DEO Singh said. "So far, the girls have studied in a secure environment. Now, they have to make their own

Experts asked KGBV alumni to recognise aptitudes and capabilities before charting out a career. They spoke on skills needed for various careers, competitive exams, vocational options and institutions the girls might access. In a separate session, girls asked questions to the expert panel.

Later, Babita, who scored 69.4 per cent in inter-mediate, said she wanted to be a teacher as she had a nurturing personality.

"I always looked after and taught my younger siblings when my parents worked in the fields," said the Chakulia girl. Her friend Malho Tudu from Rajdoha in Potka block said she wanted to be a BDO (block development officer). Smiled the girl who scored 68.8 per cent. "BDOs are the most respected in villages." What did she learn from this workshop? "That I need to graduate and prepare well for civil services exams to be a BDO," said Malho.

Babita added that for her family, education till Class VIII was more than enough. "But now I know how vast the world is," she said.

City B-school, tech college on nat'l list

Kolkata: A national ranking of top 100 private tech schools and 50 B-schools was published by Education World, a Bangalore-based magazine, where the city-based Heritage Institute of Technology and Heritage Business School are the only ones featured from the state.

Education World has been ranking different categories of private educational institutions, from pre-schools to universities, for some time.

HIT ranked 89th among the top 100 private engineering colleges in the country while Heritage Business School bagged the 47th spot among 50.

Both institutes are celebrating, but said that they will try their best to ring in changes that will push them up several notches.

"We need to concentrate on our R&D. Though we have 85 PhD holders as our faculty, we would like to cross 100 over the next two years. Our intake of 900 students left no vacancies in any stream, which was not seen even in government-run engineering schools," said CEO of HIT Pradipt Agarwal.

Birla Institute of Technology and Science (BITS) Pilani has ranked first with an impressive score of 2,060 out of 2,300. Thesecond and third positions were bagged by Vellore Institute of Technology with 2,054 and International Institute of Information Technology, Hyderabad with 2,045. HIT scored 1,576 and shares the rank with another private engineering college from Hyderabad, MLR Institute of Technology. HIT impressed the assessors with competence of faculty which carried 350, where it scored 286.

In industry interface and infrastructure interface, carrying 300 marks each, HIT scored 248 and 213 respectively. In research and innovation, HIT managed 122 out of 300.

Among private B-schools, Indian School of Business has topped with 1,336 out of 1,600, followed closely by XLRI Jamshedpur (1,335) and SP Jain Institute, Mumbai (1,279). Heritage Business School scored 1,027 and its chairman H P Budhia received the award.
