Doing its groundwork before the formal launch on Sunday, currently, the start-up already has around 10 clients and has decided to expand beyond Jharkhand.

XLRI's entrepreneurship cell has also decided to engage Vikrobit to popularise its Start-up quiz by reaching out to 5,000 school students in Jamshedpur via an online test. "This new age is all about promoting start-ups and new ideas. It makes me happy
